The Legislature Meeting

The Genesee County Legislature Meetings are held on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month. July, August, and December meetings are held on the second Wednesday only. Meetings begin at 7:00pm.

Privileges of the Floor may be extended to appropriate individuals by the Chair of the Legislature. A person other than a County Legislator may request permission to address the Legislature on any matter to be considered at the session.

A Resolution is an item on which the entire Legislature votes. A resolution is generally brought before the legislature by a Standing Committee. Each committee has a Chairman appointed by the Chairman of the Legislature and is composed of four members. There are three Standing Committees, Ways & Means, Human Service and Public Service. Each County Department Head is responsible to a particular committee. Generally, the committees meet once or twice a month. The schedule can be obtained from the Legislature Office.

If a Department Head has an action item, it is presented to Committee. The Committee votes for approval. If approved, the action item resolution is brought before the entire Legislature for a vote. By State Law, each Legislator has a weighted vote determined by population. After approval by the Legislature, the Clerk of the Legislature sends certified copies to appropriate

personnel and the Department Head takes any appropriate action.

It may appear that some items being voted on are dealt with briefly, however, these topics have been discussed at length in Committee Meetings.

County Manager

Jay Gsell is appointed by the Legislature and is responsible to them for carrying out the overall administration of County Government. Specific responsibilities include overall directions and supervision of County Departments; providing input to the Legislature on policy issues and carrying out adopted policies, and preparation of and control over the County Budget.

County Attorney

John Rizzo is the legal advisor for the Legislature and every officer who is an employee of the County in all matters involving an official act of a civil nature.

Clerk of the Legislature

Carolyn Pratt is appointed by the Legislature. The wide variety of duties and responsibilities range from clerical to representing the Legislature as a Public Official. This office lives according to calendars and under the ever pressing need of meeting deadlines. The office is the source of reliable information, research arm, and the individuals to keep the Legislature abreast of any changes.
