To Art Teachers and Educators: Please consider joining our efforts to make voting in Genesee County a community endeavor. We will be picking a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner and a Grand Prize entry will be printed into the "I Voted" stickers that our poll workers distribute to voters during Early Voting and on Election Day. Other entries may be used in community outreach and on the Genesee County Board of Elections website and social media pages and the Genesee County website and social media pages.

- All entrants must be in 5th—12th Grade and enrolled in a Genesee County School District or Homeschool program
- All artwork submitted must be your original work; no stock or borrowed images may be used
- Artwork that has offensive language, violence, drugs, gangs, weaponry, etc. will not be considered
- Entries must include the words "I Voted"
- Artwork must be nonpartisan
- Entries may be created on paper or digitally—keep in mind artwork will be made into a round sticker. Suggested design tip use a paper plate as a template for paper submissions
- Paper entries must be either scanned or photographed clearly for submission
- Digital & Paper files must be under 1GB, and must be a .pdf, .png, .jpg, or jpeg
- Entries will be used for social media and other marketing materials for the Genesee County Board of Elections and the winning design will be made into "I Voted" stickers for the General Election
