

Present: Legislators Stein, Cianfrini, Clattenburg, Deleo. Also Present: Legislature Clerk LaGrou, Health Department Deputy Director David Whitcroft, County Attorney Charles Zambito, Nursing Home Administrator Christine Schaller, Sheriff's Deputy Greg Parker, Daily News Reporter Jim Krencik

Chair Stein called the meeting to order at 4:26 PM at the Old Courthouse. The minutes of the January 11, 2016 meeting were approved upon motion of Legislator Deleo seconded by Legislator Cianfrini.

Health Department Deputy Director Whitcroft presented on an addendum to the service agreement with P2 Collaborative of WNY. The extension is needed due to changes with the website design which is one of the deliverables of the grant. This was approved for placement on the next Legislature Agenda upon motion of Legislator Cianfrini seconded by Legislator Deleo.

Legislator Cianfrini clarified there is a contract for services and all of the services have not been completed during the contract period therefore more time is requested at no additional cost. Health Department Deputy Director Whitcroft confirmed that was the case, due to back and forth with a web designer. Health educators from Orleans, Wyoming and Genesee are working on administering this grant. Legislator Deleo asked if it was anticipated that the deliverables will be met with the requested extension. Legislator Cianfrini clarified the length of the extension which is six months. Mr. Whitcroft stated that they anticipate a six month extension will be adequate for completion.

Next, Mr. Whitcroft presented a resolution requesting a contract for provision of Sexually Transmitted Disease diagnosis and treatment services with Workfit Medical, LLC for the period of March 1, 2016 through December 31, 2018. This was approved for placement on the next Legislature Agenda upon motion of Legislator Deleo seconded by Legislator Cianfrini.

Chairwoman Stein clarified that this will change the current system of providing an open clinic to a cost per service arrangement. Mr. Whitcroft confirmed. Legislator Clattenburg asked how they determined Workfit, LLC was the provider they would recommend. Mr. Whitcroft explained the next resolution is for UMMC, allowing for two providers. Workfit, LLC provides multiple services such as drug testing. Sheriff Deputy Greg Parker asked for permission to address the committee chair after stating his name. He stated that the Sheriff's Department is responsible for transporting inmates from the jail for testing and asked if Workfit, LLC is located in Rochester. Chairwoman Stein clarified that they have a local presence on Washington Street in Batavia. Legislator Clattenburg clarified that we will not pay Workfit, LLC because they will bill directly.

Next, Mr. Whitcroft presented a resolution requesting a contract for provision of Sexually Transmitted Disease diagnosis and treatment services with United Memorial Medical

Center. This was approved for placement on the next Legislature Agenda upon motion of Legislator Cianfrini seconded by Legislator Deleo.

Nursing Home Director Schaller presented a contract that allows for 4 additional one year renewals upon written consent of both parties with Freedom Therapy for rehabilitation services. The administrator recommends the contract be extended for the second of these one-year renewals through February, 28, 2017. Chairwoman Stein commented that upon her request, language was added to the resolution indicating the contract is subject to approval of the county attorney and shall include a thirty-day termination clause, without cause. This was approved for placement on the next Legislature Agenda upon motion of Legislator Clattenburg seconded by Legislator Deleo.

Next, Nursing Home Director Schaller presented a contract with Russell Phillips & Associates for Life Safety Compliance and Code Equivalency Services at a cost of \$9,500. Upon survey by the NYS Health Department of the facility, it was found that the stairwells do not meet the Life Safety code. The company will perform a life safety code compliance evaluation. This evaluation is done on a point system and the expectation is there will be enough points generated from other aspects of the evaluation to allow for a waiver. This was approved for placement on the next Legislature Agenda upon motion of Legislator Clattenburg seconded by Legislator Cianfrini.

County Attorney Zambito commented that the deal with Premier states that anything brought to the County's attention is the County's responsibility therefore the issue needs to be addressed. Chairwoman Stein asked for information on how Russell Phillips was recommended. Director Schaller explained that the Health Department likes to work with them.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:50 pm upon motion of Legislator Cianfrini seconded by Legislator Deleo.
