In 2008 Volunteers For Animals spent over \$50,000 on veterinary care, medications, tests, and spay/neuter surgeries. Every animal leaves the Shelter with certain vaccines, flea/worming treatment, and tests. We also treat animals if they come into the Shelter with upper respiratory infections, parasites, ear mites, bite wounds, skin infections, malnutrition, broken bones, heartworm and much more. Here are the breakdown of some of these costs:
